DEFINING IART

Immediate Action Response (Training)



Immediate Action response refers to a series of actions to be taken in face of a SPECIFIC THREAT of EMERGENCY SITUATION

STANDARD RESPONSE PROTOCL

Created using an "all-hazards" concept with wide-ranging applicability; primes responses into four standard options

If you think a situation is developing...

ARMED INTRUDER RESPONSE Follow the A.L.I.C.E. model







CRISIS MANAGER







- 1. Lockdown is used when an armed intruder enters campus or is in a building. Lockdown is meant to keep persons in one safe location when there is an unknown threat outside of the classroom or buildings. If there is a threat to the campus from an armed intruder, immediately call 9-1-1 and Campus Safety at x333.
 - Lockdown will be followed by the directive "Locks, Lights, Out of Sight" and is the protocol used to secure individual rooms and keep everyone quiet and in place.
 - Normal Campus Operations will <u>CEASE</u> until the "ALL CLEAR" order is given by Campus Safety or Senior Administration.
- Lockout is used to secure the campus perimeter when Campus Safety and/or local law enforcement has been notified of a person(s) of interest.
