Immediate Action Response (Training)



Immediate Action response refers to a series of actions
to be taken in face of a
SPECIFIC THREAT of EMERGENCY SITUATION

STANDARD RESPONSE PROTOCL

Created using an “all-hazards” concept with wide-ranging applicability; primes responses into four standard options

Use Your Intuition

Don't automatically assume that nothing is going on.

Take Action

Do not wait for others to validate

Notify Authorities

Only when it is safe to do so

Evacuate

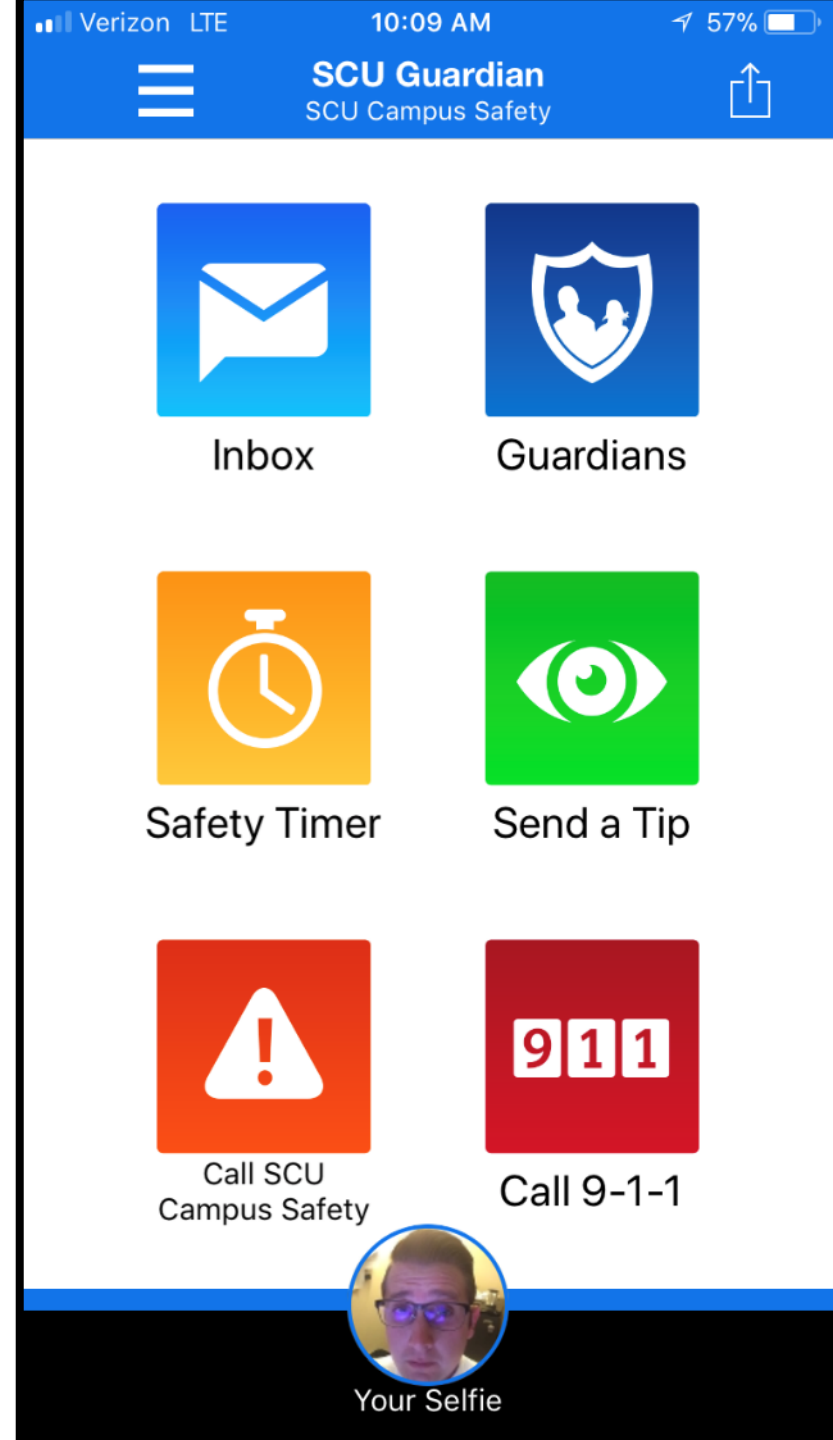
