Summary of the Title IX Process

| Step | Description |
|--------------------------------|---|
| Report Submission | Report can be made to the Title IX Coordinator, Deputy Coordinator, or online. |
| Initial Assessment | Coordinator assesses the report, offers supportive measures, and determines next steps. |
| Supportive Measures | Non-disciplinary services provided to complainant and respondent to maintain access to education. |
| Investigation | Formal investigation if the report warrants it; includes interviews, evidence collection, and report preparation. |
| Decision Making | Hearing to determine if policy was violated; outcomes include sanctions and remedies. |
| Notification of Outcome | Both parties are informed of the outcome and any sanctions or remedies. |
| Appeals Process | Either party may appeal the decision based on specific grounds. |
| Implementation of Sanctions | Sanctions or remedies are enforced, and supportive measures are adjusted as necessary. |
