

Summary of the Title IX Process

Step	Description
Report Submission	Report can be made to the Title IX Coordinator, Deputy Coordinator, or online.
Initial Assessment	Coordinator assesses the report, offers supportive measures, and determines next steps.
Supportive Measures	Non-disciplinary services provided to complainant and respondent to maintain access to education.
Investigation	Formal investigation if the report warrants it; includes interviews, evidence collection, and report preparation.
Decision Making	Hearing to determine if policy was violated; outcomes include sanctions and remedies.
Notification of Outcome	Both parties are informed of the outcome and any sanctions or remedies.
Appeals Process	Either party may appeal the decision based on specific grounds.
Implementation of Sanctions	Sanctions or remedies are enforced, and supportive measures are adjusted as necessary.
