## EQUAL ACCESS TO EDUCATION

You have the right to an education free from sex- or gender-based discrimination.

## PROTECTION FROM SEXUAL HARRASMENT

Unwelcome sexual conduct, comments, or behavior is not tolerated.

## CONSENT IS MANDATORY

Sexual activity must be knowing, voluntary, and clear; without it, it's prohibited.

## REPORT WITHOUT FEAR

You can report concerns to the Title IX Office without fear of retaliation.

## SUPPORTIVE MEASURES

You have access to academic and safety-related accommodations even if no formal complaint is filed.

## PROMPT & THOROUGH RESPONSE

All reports are taken seriously and investigated promptly in accordance with policy.

## FAIR & IMPARTIAL PROCESS

Both complainants and respondents have the right to a fair, timely, and unbiased process.
